


MyCC: Viewing Grades

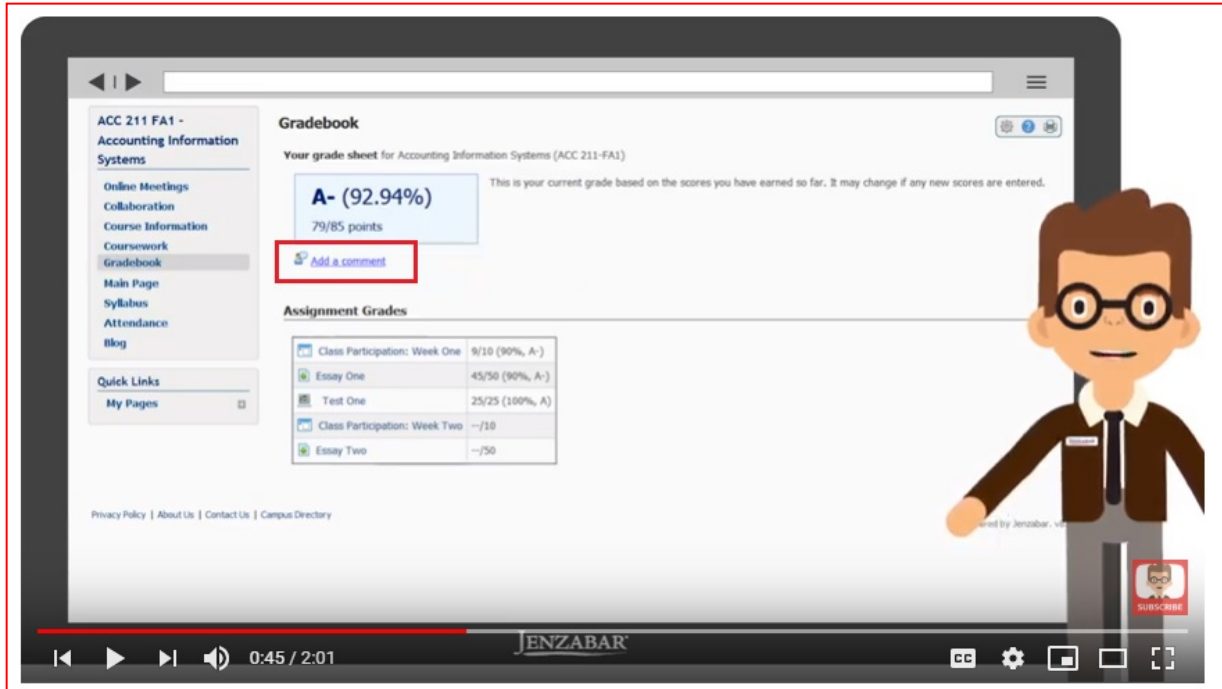

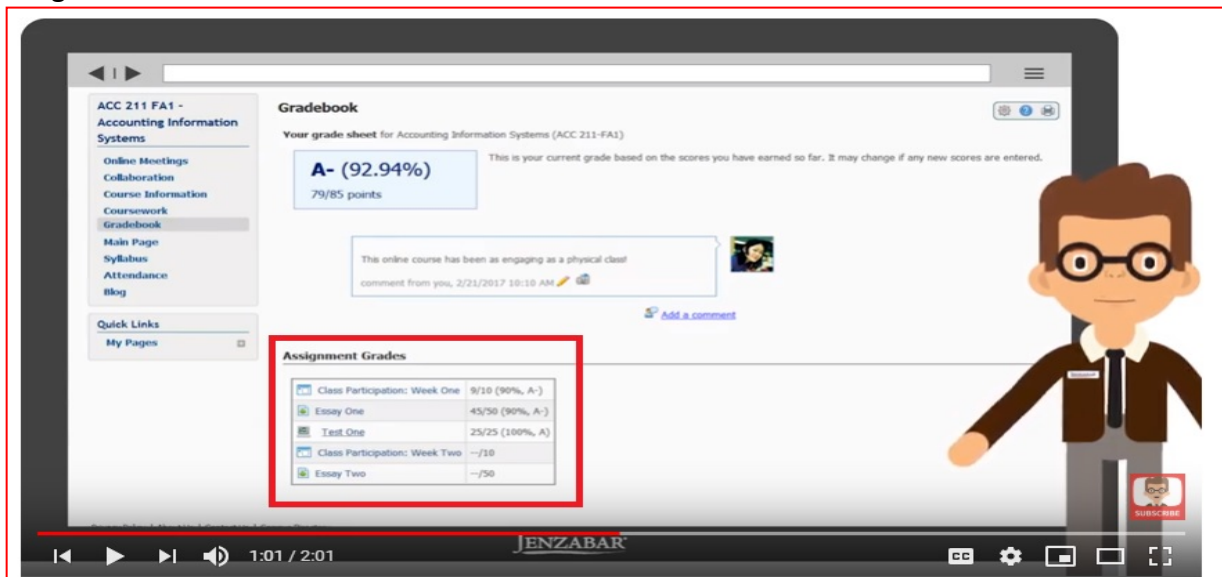
Commenting on Grades

Comment on the grade is private and can be only read by you and your professor right below the course grade.



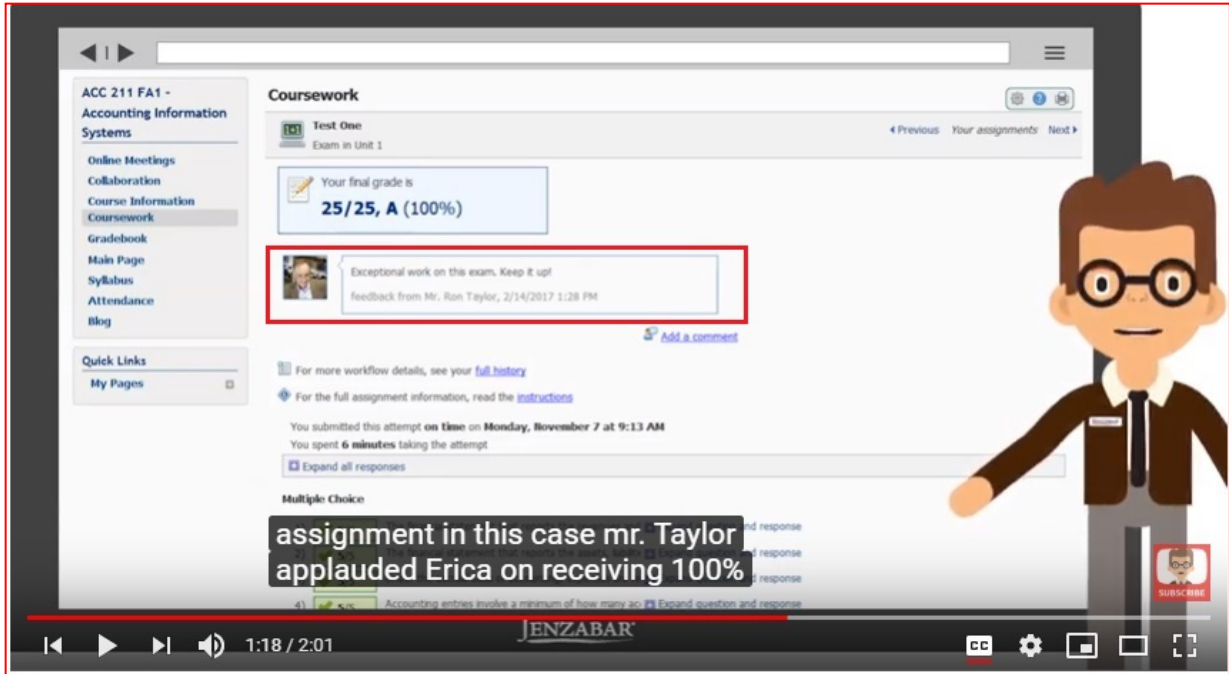
Grades for Individual Assignment
